



COVID-19 has proven to be a serious threat to everyone in our country and ASL Productions has installed a set of strict protocols to address concerns of spreading the virus on our sets. Everyone on location at any of our shoots is instructed to follow these guidelines or is immediately removed. ASL is COVID-19 compliance certified and we make sure to follow through on all guidelines. We take these protocols very seriously and expect our producers, crew, talent and clients to do the same.

ASL Productions COVID-19 On Location Guidelines

- We provide a highly-experienced production crew with ZERO Covid-19 symptoms. All crew takes and records own temperature the day before and the morning of the shoot.
- Crews will follow all CDC guidelines, local guidelines and corporate specific guidelines
- Before the shoot, the crew carefully wipes down all equipment with disinfectant wipes or 70% alcohol solution.
- Before entering the location, the crew puts on a brand new sterile mask and will wear gloves if needed or requested.
- The production crew will carry spare masks, gloves, sanitizing wipes, tissues, and hand sanitizer.
- Hands are carefully sanitized once per hour on location, in accordance with CDC guidelines.
- The interviewee / talent stays out of the room during setup.
- The interviewee / talent does his / her own hair and makeup unless otherwise requested, with optional remote coaching from our makeup artist via video conferencing.

- The production crew maintains approved social distancing (at least 6 feet away) at all times when possible.
- We use a boom pole microphone and / or allow the interviewee to self-place a sterilized lavalier microphone if preferred.
- Optional: We send the Client a direct feed from the camera to see the entire shoot in real time remotely. (This involves a bit of extra equipment and setup time.)
- If the shot needs to be adjusted, the talent leaves the room if needed to maintain social distancing.
- Interviews can be conducted by a remote Director via Zoom, Skype, or any similar platform. The Client can watch and/or participate.




